From 121 consultations sent out to parents with children on our school roll we received 7 responses.

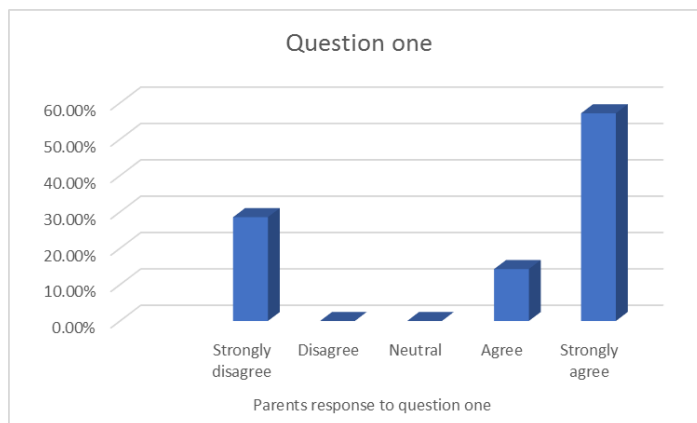

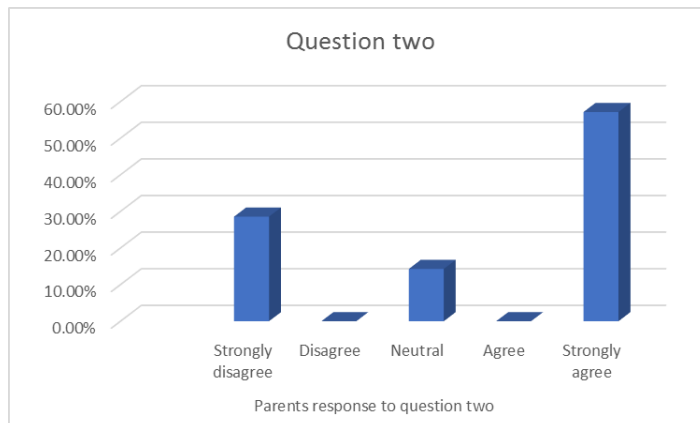

### **Outline of Questions and their responses:**

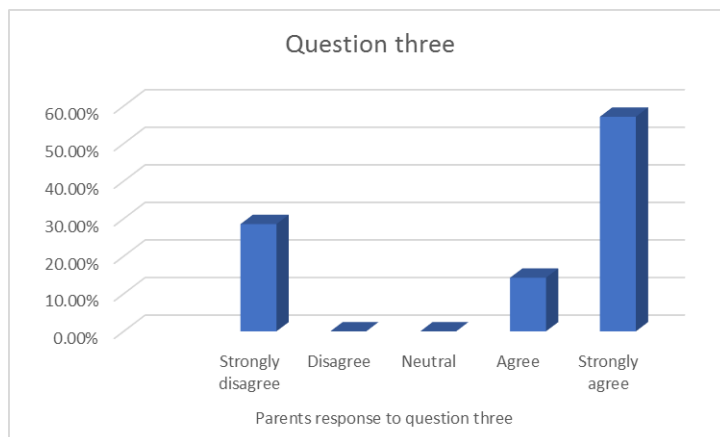
1. I think PSHE/RSE education is an important part of the school curriculum.



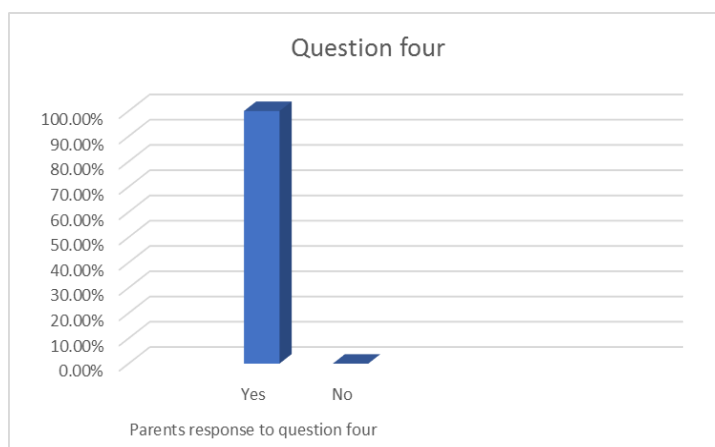
2. PSHE/RSE topics taught in school can make a real difference to young people's lives.



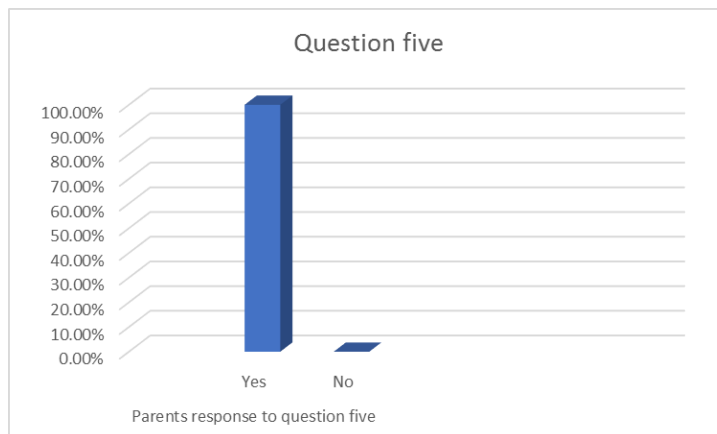
3. I feel happy to talk to my child about growing up, sex and relationships.



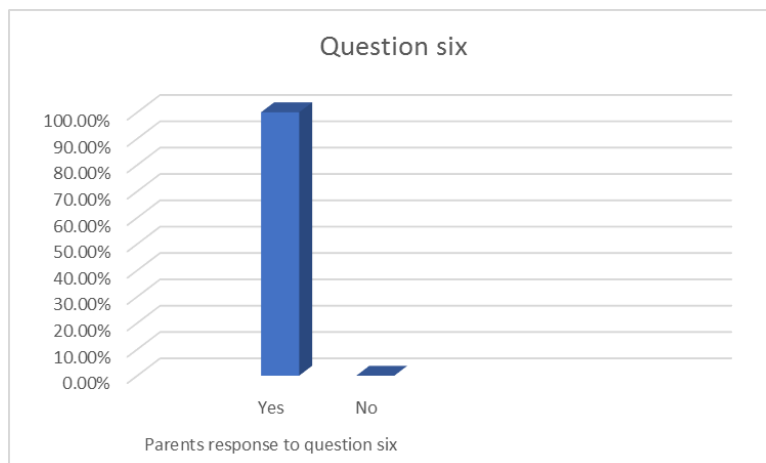
4. I am aware of the topic that will be covered in the RSE sessions at Two Rivers Primary.



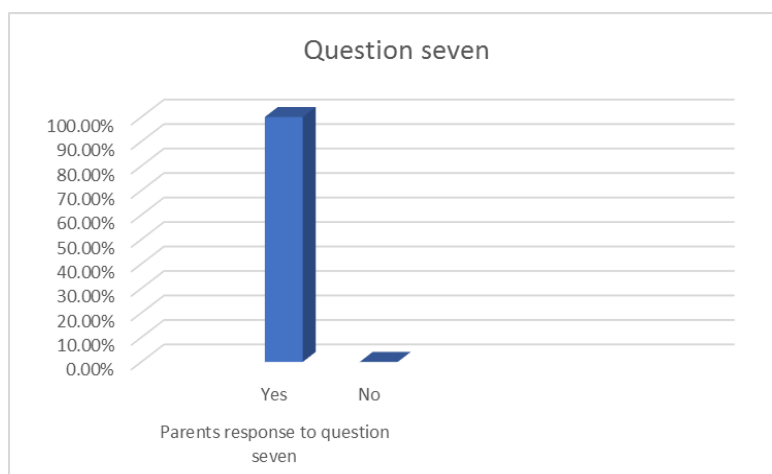
5. I understand and agree with the content of the RSE policy (found on school website).



6. Are there any changes/ additions that you think should be made?

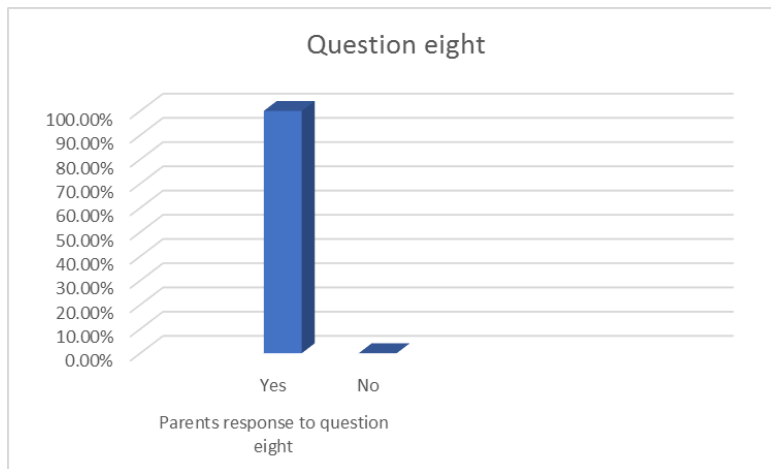


7. Are there any topics we aren't covering in our RSE curriculum that you think we should be?
