# Uniform Policy

It is our policy that all wear school uniform when attending school, representing the school, or when participating in a school-organised event outside normal school hours. The aim is that pupils of Two Rivers High School will develop and feel a sense of community and belonging through the wearing of the school uniform. From time to time, some issues of safety and comfort for individual pupils which may necessitate some changes to the normal uniform can be taken into consideration. Items of jewellery which could be a health and safety risk are not allowed.

The school asks that the uniform detailed below be followed:

## SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS

School uniform is compulsory. It can be purchased from a number of outlets including

Alternatively, you may purchase a **plain** sweatshirt in the correct colour from any high street chain store or supermarket.

### Main School

Navy blue sweatshirt/cardigan  
White polo shirt  
Black trousers or skirt  
Plain black shoes/black trainers



### Pioneer (Year 11+)

Black sweatshirt/cardigan  
White polo shirt/blouse  
Black trousers or skirt  
Plain black shoes/black trainers

A navy blue waterproof jacket is available with the school logo on

### PE

Black shorts  
White T-shirt – available with the logo  
Trainers – must have non-marking soles for the sports hall  
Tracksuit/Jumper is advisable in cold conditions  
Rugby shirt (optional)

### Swimming

Trunks (NOT shorts) for boys  
Swimsuit and swimming hat for girls  
Towel  
NO GOGGLES

(A kit is provided by school when representing a team)

Two Rivers High School also have an on-site shop of pre-loved items where we can provide items of school clothing. Please ask the office for more information.

Please do NOT buy black pumps to use for PE as they do not support the foot and ankle when running. Students will be doing PE outside on the field or in the Sports Hall. If they are doing gymnastics, dance or trampolining they will be in bare feet. They may wear specialised dance shoes or trampoline shoes if they own them but please do not buy these especially.

If students need to be excused from PE for any reason, please provide a note of explanation or leave a message with the school office.

### **Forest School**

During Forest School lessons students are advised to wear a coat, hat and gloves in the cold weather and a sun hat in the summer. Wellies and waterproof clothing are provided by the school although students can bring their own if preferred.
