

## Parent Satisfaction Survey 2022/2023 – Two Rivers Primary School

During the 6<sup>th</sup> week of Autumn Term 2021 and 2022 we canvassed the parents and carers at Two Rivers Primary School, during parents evening, for their thoughts and feelings about how the school is operating for their family. We offered all parents an opportunity to complete and return the questionnaire (in 2021/2022 this was 134 families), in 2022/2023 this was **126** families and we received (44 responses in 2021/2022) **52** responses in 2022/2023 – the outline below shares the information from these responses (not all parents and carers responded to every question). I have included last year and this year's responses, so that we can look at if the school has made progress over time and to help us further plan for this academic year.

## Actions for school to consider moving forward:

- ➡ To revisit our total homework provision for all learners to better publicise this with all parents and carers. (Last year, our approach concentrated on the teaching of reading and offering online reading provision for homework for our children)
- To share better information about our behaviour policy and approach with parents (including how we manage bullying). We will share our Behaviour Standards and include them in the creation of this approach this year.

- Improve communication about children's progress with parents ensuring that we develop materials that outline the progress made against expected outcomes.
- To look at our new communication app the endeavour app and ensure that all classes are sharing information about the children's day in an appropriate way.

## Conclusion:

We are really pleased with the positive responses from parents, and the general upward position of most of the data. It is great that we are now able to offer routinely accessible events for parents and carers and hope that this will continue to develop our close working relationships. It continues to be very important that we continue to work together to meet the needs of all our learners.
