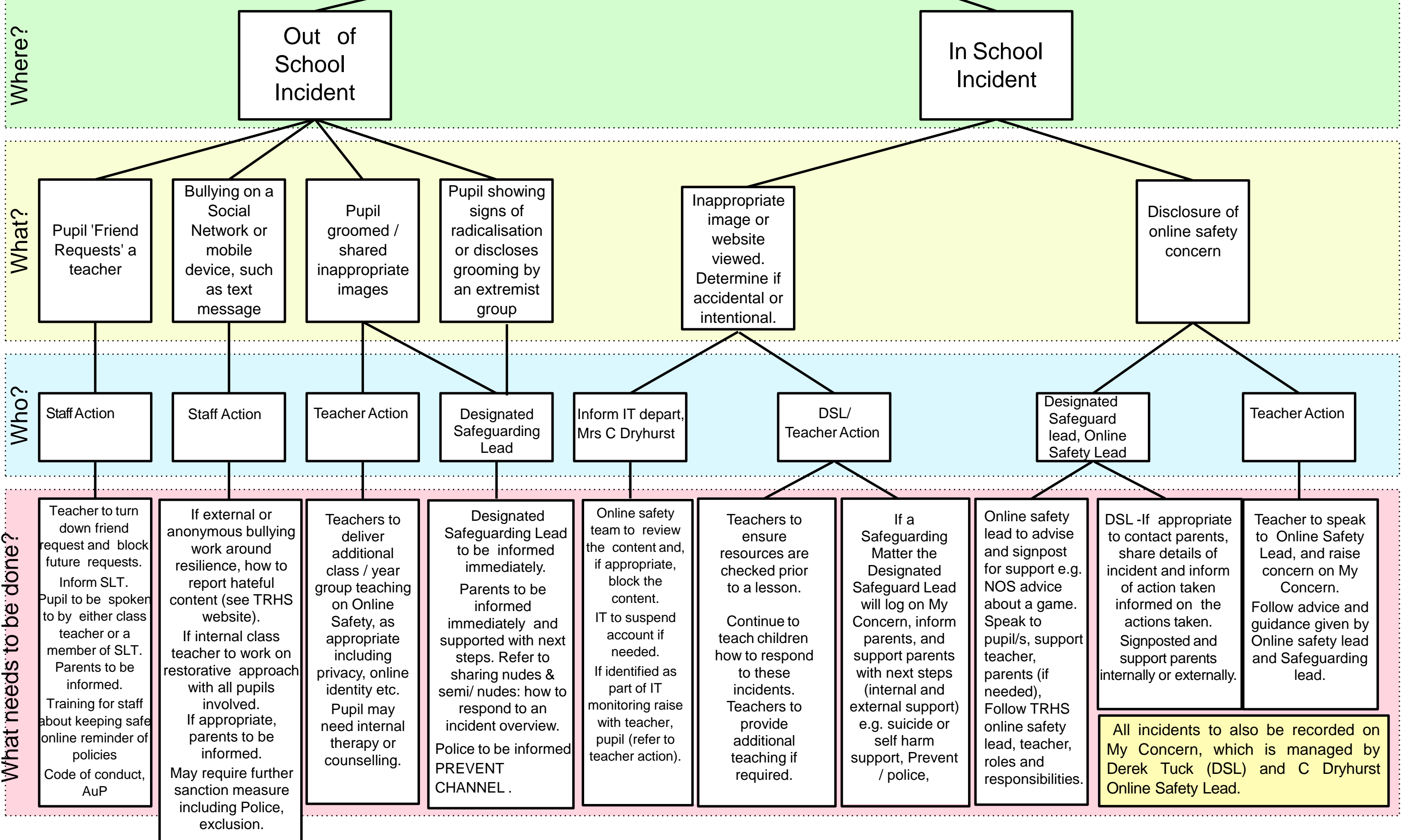




In the event of an Online Safety incident, follow this flowchart to identify what actions should be taken and by whom.
