

- To help support mainstream staff in providing Quality First Teaching for all.
- To increase staff confidence with managing and teaching children with additional needs
- To provide staff with a toolkit, enabling them to de-escalate challenging behaviour
- To provide direct support for school leaders with the **graduated response** of a child
- To provide detailed reports that will give school staff some of the strategies needed to de-escalate behaviour, help **emotionally regulate** pupils.
- To provide detailed reports that will give school staff strategies needed to support inclusion for **SEND** needs including **Autism**.
- To deliver whole school training on a range of strategies that can be added to school staffs toolkit when dealing with challenging behaviour
- To provide support with Positive Behaviour Support Plan writing
- To reduce incidents of challenging behaviour which may otherwise affect a child's ability to be included in a lesson.
- To offer suggestions for the **differentiation** or **adaptation** of tasks within a classroom.
- To provide sensory processing disorder training to staff, highlighting awareness of the disorder and enabling staff to manage children's behaviour accordingly.
- To provide direct support to staff teams on the implementation of Sensory Processing Disorder programmes.
- To provide individual sensory processing disorder assessments.
- To reduce incidents of sensory seeking behaviour which may otherwise affect a child's ability to be included in a lesson.
- To provide therapeutic support in the following:
 - Music Therapy
 - Play Therapy
 - Lego Therapy
 - Drawing & Talking Therapy
