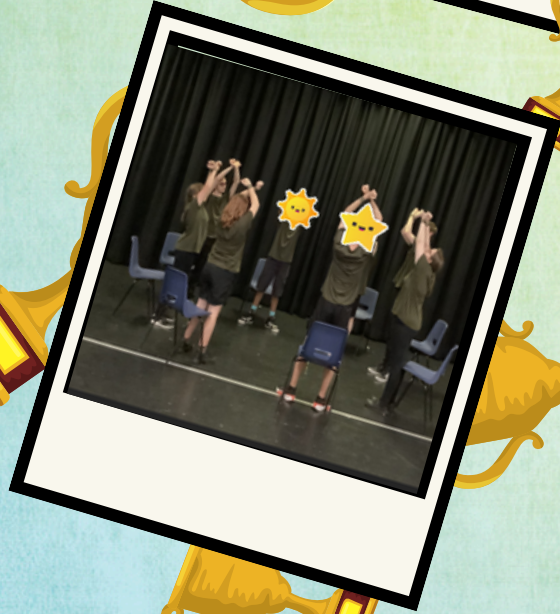

The Very Hungry Caterpillar and sharing our favourite stories with each other.

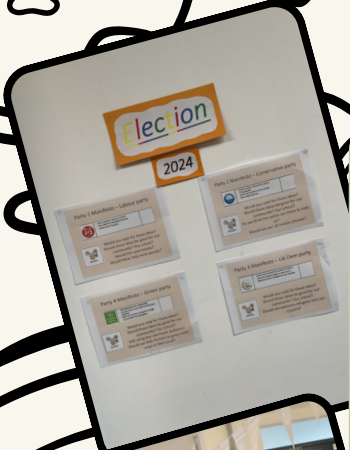
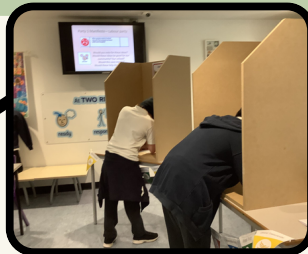
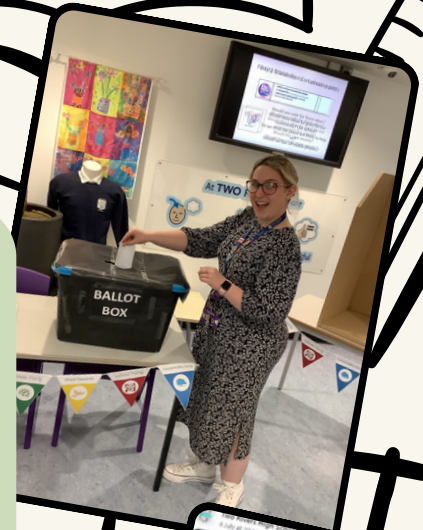
We did some beautiful mark making alongside the story
