The School Day

- Currently, we offer a supervised morning play session for drop off at 8am for the cost of £3 each day, simply call the office the day before to book. For those transported into school by parent's school starts at 9.15am.
- If you bring your child to school, please do not arrive before 9.15 am. We ask that you drop off your child at their designated entrance. Any letters etc. must be handed in to staff on the gate, please don't put correspondence in your child's bag, as this can get lost.
- We operate a staggered start, with our transport as it gets very busy at the start and end of the day when the buses are unloading, so please be aware of children, wheelchairs, buggies etc. as you leave.
- All children will be given a reading bag and a log in letter for our communication apps (Class Dojo, Evidence for Learning and Arbor) – please use this to keep in touch with the classroom staff.
- Any urgent queries please phone the school office and ask for one of the Senior Leadership Team and one of them will get back to you as soon as possible

- For parents who collect, school finishes at 3.15pm. If you are collecting your child, please arrive promptly but no earlier than 3.15pm and wait at the designated entrance and your child will be brought to you.
- If your child has been given a seat on the school transport you will be notified of pick up/drop off times, drivers and escort name etc. by Staffordshire County Council. This will usually be towards the end of August. They can be contacted on 01785 278213.
- Letters and correspondence should come to school via the passenger assistant – please use a sealed envelope if it is private and confidential.
- If your child is ill and unable to attend school or has a medical appointment **please ring the school office**, as soon as possible and give Gill brief details of the illness. You will be called if we have not received a message from you to check that all is ok.
- If you are unable to collect your child from school, you must inform us as to who will be collecting them. You will be asked to provide a **password**.
- We will not send a child home with a substitute parent if you have not informed us beforehand.
- We have to operate the Staffordshire policy on refusing leave for holidays during school time. If you can provide evidence of extenuating circumstances or need for respite, we will **CONSIDER** your request.
- Details of after school clubs/activities will be sent out as and when they are running.

Safeguarding

- If your child has an accident at home please inform either myself, the school nurse or the class teacher as soon as possible as we will investigate any unexplained or unusual marks and bruises etc.
- There is information on the parents board and website about what to do if you think a child is not safe.
