Dear Parents and Carers,

For some of you this is your first letter from school and for others it is a little while since I last wrote to you about the plans we wish to make around transition to Two Rivers Primary School and EYFS in September 2020.

I am Laura Slinn and I am the Executive Headteacher of Two Rivers Primary School and EYFS. I am writing to welcome you and your child to the school. We are really looking forward to working with you in September and all through your child's school career.

Today I am writing about transition. This would normally be a 3 stage process where we would welcome you and your families in to school to begin to help settle in and enjoy your time. Sadly, due to the current situation we are not able to make that offer to you. Instead we are creating a virtual approach to transition this side of the Summer holiday and will work hard with your children in September when they begin school, to allow them to feel comfortable and welcome.

For each family we have created a welcome pack. I would like to invite you to collect your child's welcome pack from Two Rivers Primary School, Quince, Tamworth, B77 4EN on Thursday 11th or Friday 12th June between 9am and 3:30pm. Once you have this pack, please look through and complete the information requested. When you have completed the information, I ask that you contact school on 01827 426123 and make an appointment to return it. During your returning appointment a senior leader will be able to walk you and your child around the school – we will not be able to enter classrooms due to them being used by other pupils, but you will be able to look through the windows in the doors, see the playgrounds and share in our communal areas. For those who will be attending the EYFS provision, your tour will be arranged for that site (at the Torc centre, Silverlink Road). We do ask, that if you feel poorly or are displaying any symptoms of the Corona Virus – such as high temperature, persistent cough or loss of taste and smell that you do not attend a tour, but instead contact us again when you are feeling better and we will rearrange this with you.

You are then all invited to attend a virtual Zoom meeting with myself on Thursday 18th June at 10am – here you will be able to share in our normal presentation and ask questions. This presentation will later be recorded and will be accessible on our website, so that if you cannot make the meeting you will not miss out.
