Lifeskills → Moving Forward → Lifeskills

- Up to a possible 56 hours of individual support is available from our Moving Forward programme to help young people with a Special Educational Need or Disability (SEND) towards achieving their dreams or goals and to develop essential lifeskills for their future.
- Young people are free to choose the skills they would like to develop or activities that they would like to try and our Providers from across Staffordshire can help them to achieve their individual goals.
- To take part, young people must be 11-18 years old with a Special Educational Need or Disability (SEND) and live in Staffordshire. Young people up to the age of 25 can also take part if they have an Education Health and Care Plan and are not already accessing Adult Social Care services.
- Support is **FREE** however young people may need to pay for some activities accessed as part of this.
- Examples of the type of support available can be found below, however, our Providers are always happy to talk about other ways they may be able to help.
