

Two Rivers High School Remote Learning for Pupils

The Blended Approach

All pupils working remotely will receive a home learning pack. The work included in the pack will be supplemented and supported by online lessons delivered over Microsoft Teams and activities sent via email or Class Dojo.

You will be sent a timetable for the online lessons. If your child cannot access these sessions, for whatever reason, please let the teacher know. We will do our best to support.

As the weeks progress, further work will be posted online, delivered to your door by school staff or sent through the post.

It is important that we are able to see the work your child has done so that we can check for understanding and then plan the next step accordingly. You can photograph their work and send it to us as an image, either on the portfolio page of Class Dojo, or by email. Alternatively, the work may be sent as a document instead of as an image. Short videos can also be uploaded to the portfolio page of Dojo.

In addition to the work set by teachers, we may direct your child to activities and learning opportunities provided by trusted external agencies, such as BBC Bitesize, National Geographic Kids, Oak National Academy and Oxford Owl.

As usual, if you have any concerns about the lessons and learning, please contact your child's teacher in the first instance or leave a message on the school phone and we will get back to you.
